1. Feedback on new and existing terms- GP and other intern terms and Hobart Private Annexe

All reports on the terms have been accepted and ongoing monitoring of the terms will be undertaken by the Directors of Clinical Training (DCTs) and MEAs at each of the health services. Reports will be provided to the PMCT Accreditation Committee by the DCTs at each PMCT AC meeting.

2. Updating existing policy documents, in relation to accreditation processes

All policy documents have been updated and new ones also approved to cover the mid-cycle review process. These documents have been updated on the PMCT website.

3. Mid-cycle accreditation review

PMCT AC started the mid-cycle review process on 10 June 2019 with the documents being sent to THS NW. This is our first mid-cycle review which is a desktop audit. The mid-cycle review is part of the four year accreditation cycle and any new terms can only be accredited a maximum of two years to bring all accreditation dates into alignment. All sites will undergo the mid-cycle review which will carry over into 2020.
